



Alpha/Bravo Squadron Commanders

Job Description

The Alpha/Bravo Squadron Commander is responsible for leading and organizing the Cadet Group in mass formations. The Alpha/Bravo Squadron Commander will report directly to the Cadet Group Commander or his/her Deputy.



Alpha/Bravo Squadron Commanders

Job Description

1. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander must be able to keep proper discipline, maintaining their uniform and keeping proper grooming always to lead by example. They must also be able to delegate different tasks throughout their squadron without causing any problems and confusion.
2. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander will take control of the squadrons during mass formations to include special events, parades, and Unit Evaluations.
3. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander should be able to give commands without hesitation in front of a small or big crowd.
4. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander must be knowledgeable of drill and ceremonies procedures.
5. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander is responsible for conducting fair and objective uniform inspections during required events. He/She will be responsible to report to Cadet Group leadership if any discrepancies exist.

Requirements



The Alpha/Bravo Squadron Commander Position is normally assigned to an Upper Classman Cadet (AS-2/AS-4), who displays leadership and communication skills necessary to manage all the tasks assigned to the position.

The minimum rank for this position is a Cadet Captain

The minimum Aerospace Science (AS) level for this position is an AS-2

This position is highly recommended for cadets who possess the communication and managerial skills needed to take charge of a flight of cadets at all times. Additionally, such cadet must be able to represent the AFJROTC program as a primary ambassador to the mission.

6. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander is responsible in the selection of a Squadron Guidon Bearer. He/She must ensure selected cadet is knowledgeable with Guidon Bearer procedures.
7. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander will practice, and teach drill. He/She will lead the squadrons/flights in drill practice days.
8. Works hand-in-hand with Squadron First Sergeant.
9. The Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander position will only be active during aforementioned events and must hold an additional leadership position in the Cadet Group in order to keep the designated rank. If unable to hold position at other times, the Alpha or Bravo Squadron Commander will return to their permanent rank once event ends.
