Job Description

1. The Cadet Kitty Hawk Commander plays an important role in the Cadet Corps. He/She is entrusted with the academic success of the Cadets enabling them to be recognized for academic excellence and to assist those cadets who are struggling academically.
2. Presides over all Kitty Hawk meetings and maintains accurate attendance records.
3. Promotes high academic excellence.
4. Establishes a tutoring program to aid cadets in need of academic help.
5. Coordinates with SASI/ASIs to insure cadets have a 3.0 GPA or higher and an "A" in JROTC.
6. Reports to the Mission Support Squadron Commander.
7. Leads other cadets by setting a good example in all areas within JROTC and must maintain all requirements of the program. Failure to uphold the program's requirements will result in removal of position.
8. Is actively engaged in community service.

Requirements



The Cadet Commander for the Kitty Hawk Air Society Position is normally assigned to Junior Cadet (AS-2/AS-4), who displays leadership, high academic standards, and managerial skills necessary to manage all the tasks assigned to the position.

The minimum rank for this position is a Cadet 2nd Lieutenant

The minimum Aerospace Science (AS) level for this position is an AS-2

This position is highly recommended for cadets who have successfully completed at least one level of Cadet Leadership training and who have held a leadership position during the previous years. Attention to detail must be part of this cadet's skills necessary to perform well in this position.
