Logistics Squadron Equipment Specialist

Job Description

- The Logistics Squadron Equipment Specialist assists the Squadron Equipment NCO who manages and maintains all Air Force supplied equipment including texts, and any accountable item in the TX-922 equipment inventory, except uniform items.
- 2. Assists the SASI/ASI in the issue and turn-in of all equipment used during cadet activities.
- 3. Assists Logistics Squadron leadership in the periodic inventory of accounted property in WINGS.
- 4. Must possess a Cadet Access Account to manage logistics items to include: issue, receive, write-off, inventory, etc.
- 5. Ensures tasks are completed in order to meet the mission.
- Assists Equipment NCO with logistics inventory activities which includes IT Computer Equipment (ADPE), textbooks, DVDs, and any other accountable equipment on WINGS.
- Inspects equipment for serviceability and coordinate repair when needed.

Requirements

The Logistics Squadron Equipment Specialist Position is normally assigned to a Cadet (AS-1/AS-3), who displays leadership skills necessary to manage all the tasks assigned to the position.

The minimum rank for this position is a Cadet Airman Basic

The minimum Aerospace Science (AS) level for this position is an AS-1

This position is highly recommended for cadets who possess the managerial skills to meet squadron mission.

The Cadet Logistics Squadron Equipment Specialist must lead by example in all areas. • • •

- 8. Maintains database and records where all equipment can be properly tracked.
- 9. Maintains a neat and efficient cadet logistics area.
- 10. Advises Sq. Commander, SASI/ASI of items needed to be ordered when inventory of such item is low.
- 11. Ensures the collection and the proper storage of equipment once used.
