Job Description

- The Marksmanship Team NCO must be able to keep proper discipline, maintaining their uniform and keeping proper grooming always to lead by example. They must also be able to delegate different tasks throughout their team without causing any problems and confusion.
- The Marksmanship Team NCO assists with all Marksmanship training, ensuring all members meet the required safety standards, and their files are current.
- The Marksmanship Team NCO assists Marksmanship Team Commander with setting up and coordinate with instructors practice schedules.
- 4. Assists in reporting service credits to the LDR officer for proper accreditation of members under WINGS.
- 5. Consults with Marksmanship Team Commander with the admission of new cadets to the team.
- Helps with the proper handling, accountability, and maintenance of Marksmanship equipment in the inventory.
- Reports any discrepancies in the equipment to the Armory Commander, Logistics Squadron leadership, and/or instructors on a timely manner.

Requirements

The Marksmanship Team NCO Position is normally assigned to a Junior Cadet (AS-2/AS-4), who displays leadership and communication skills necessary to manage all the tasks assigned to the position.

The minimum rank for this position is a Cadet Staff Sergeant

The minimum Aerospace Science (AS) level for this position is an AS-2

This position is highly recommended for cadets who possess the management skills needed to provide team direction and organization in preparation for competitions. Additionally, such cadet must be able to represent the AFJROTC program as a primary ambassador to the mission.
