- 1. The Cadet Morale NCO, just like his/her counterpart, plays an important role in the Cadet Corps. He/She is entrusted to assist the Cadet Chaplain/Morale Officer with the morale and welfare of all Cadets.
- 2. Helps recommends solutions to problems concerning such areas in the Cadet Corps.
- 3. Works together with the Cadet Chaplain/Morale Officer to ensure activities are made available to the cadets to foster high morale.
- 4. Reports to the Chaplain/Morale Officer and assists with any assigned duties.
- 5. Leads by example and fosters conflict resolution when necessary.
- 6. Ensures the Cadet Corps adheres to the Air Force Core Values of Integrity first, Excellence in all we do, and, Service before self.

Requirements

The Cadet Chaplain
Position is normally
assigned to Junior Cadet
(AS-2/AS-4), who
displays leadership and
managerial skills
necessary to manage all
the tasks assigned to the
position.

The minimum rank for this position is a Cadet Staff Sergeant

The minimum Aerospace Science (AS) level for this position is an AS-2

This position is highly recommended for cadets who have successfully completed at least one level of Cadet Leadership training and who have held a leadership position during the previous years.

Attention to detail must be part of this cadet's skills necessary to perform well in this position.
