Job Description

- The Unit Historian/Photographer is responsible to report the activities of the Group and AFJROTC programs to all cadets in the Cadet Group.
- 2. Provides input to School Yearbook staff.
- 3. Ensures photo and video coverage of all cadet activities.
- Provides weekly inputs regarding cadet activities to Group Commander and instructors.
- Coordinates wit Public Affairs staff in the development of news articles and information concerning cadet activities to school and local newspaper.
- 6. Works with Public Affairs Officer to ensure cadet exposure is available through media channels.
- Coordinates imagery with Cyber Staff and instructors for the publishing of articles, images, or events for the unit's webpage and Facebook page.
- 8. Provides all Group photographic support during events.
- 9. Compiles and maintains all historical information and data pertaining to Cadet Corps establishment and activities.
- 10. Maintains displays and trophy cabinets.

Requirements

The Unit Historian and Photographer position is normally assigned to a Junior Cadet (AS-2/AS-4), who displays leadership and communication skills necessary to manage all the tasks assigned to the position.

The minimum rank for this position is a Cadet Senior Airman

The minimum Aerospace Science (AS) level for this position is an AS-2

This position is highly recommended for cadets who possess the communication skills needed to provide educational presentations to a variety of audiences. Additionally, such cadet must be able to represent the AFJROTC program as a primary ambassador to the mission.
